For certain cases, Dr. Hertzberg may recommend **Invisalign**, a state-of-the-art alternative to visible braces that is virtually undetectable. Invisalign straightens teeth using a series of clear, customized, removable appliances called aligners. You'll wear each pair of aligners for about two weeks. Your teeth move gradually, millimeter by millimeter until you reach the final alignment. You'll take them out when you eat (so you won't have to give up your favorite foods) and when you brush your teeth. IF you don't want anyone to know you're wearing braces, Invisalign is the ideal choice for you.

Clarity - translucent, clear, ceramic braces offer a cosmetic advantage because you won't have to worry about flashing a "tin grin" every time you smile. The natural beauty of your teeth will be shining through, and not your braces. Clarity ceramic braces won't stain or discolor. They'll look as good as the day they come off as the day we put them on. And the metal-lined slot allows for faster treatment. Clarity ceramic braces are clearly the ultimate fashion accessory in orthodontic wear.

The clean, classic look of stainless steel **silver braces** is always a great option. They are 30% smaller and the smooth, rounded contours also contribute to their comfort, while making it easier to maintain excellent oral hygiene.
